CECS Z DRIVE

All CECS students automatically have a network file system that appears on any system they log into in Jacaranda Hall. This network drive can be used as a storage location for personal files. The drive is labeled “CECS Z: Drive” under “My Computer”. Secure file transfer can be used to access the Z Drive from home.

OFF CAMPUS ACCESS

A UNIX prompt to the CECS servers and workstations is available, which can be accessed with SSH.

To connect to the campus wireless network, simply connect to the network named “eduroam.” You will be prompted to login.
