Presentation Description: This panel features three HSI-STEM grantees from CSU Northridge, Napa Valley College, and CSU Monterey Bay. The panelists will describe the impacts of structured interventions on student success.

CSU Northridge will discuss their HSI STEM and Transfer Articulation project, which includes two regional community colleges, that emphasizes faculty mentoring and advisement, tutoring and peer mentoring, social activities and field trips, undergraduate research, and conference participation.

Napa Valley College will focus on understanding the intersections between culture, career, and leadership. Cultivating STEM Leaders incorporates a Summer Bridge component with counseling, leadership, STEM academics; activities include instructors, participants, their parents, politicians, and high schools.

CSU Monterey Bay will discuss their structured undergraduate research program, which includes a four-semester research seminar series with a focus on high-stakes learning experiences through research presentations at professional conferences, national scholarship and fellowship applications, and statewide and national research competitions.



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
