Dr. Heather Youngs, Senior Bioenergy Analysis Fellow, UC Berkeley



Heather Youngs is a Senior Fellow at the Energy Biosciences Institute at UC Berkeley. She received her Ph.D. in Biochemistry and Molecular Biology from the Oregon Graduate Institute and went on to become NIH post-doctoral fellow at the Carnegie Institution for Plant Biology at Stanford and an Assistant Professor of Biochemistry at Michigan Technological University. Dr. Youngs has served on the California's Energy Future Committee projecting the potential for biofuels in meeting the state's greenhouse gas reduction goals. She also is the executive editor of Bioenergy Connection, a biannual publication discussing issues and advances in all areas of bioenergy.
